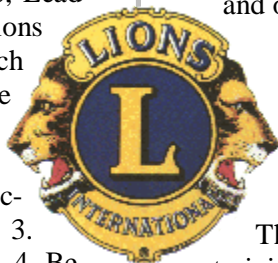
International Convention

The 82nd International Convention of Lions Clubs International was held in San Diego, California, June 28-July 2. Representing our club were Lions: Jerry Ney, PDG, Bob Bovee, PDG, Martha Bovee, and Rick Mizell.

The highlight of the convention was the election of Lion Jim Ervin to be President of Lions Clubs International. He is the first Lion from Georgia to be elected. His theme for this year is "A New Vision for a New Century of Service" with the "Four Ships of Lionism." The four ships are: "Membership, Fellowship, Leadership, and Partnership." He challenged all Lions to grow membership with a "Each one reach one Challenge." He stressed the need to invite women to become Lions. That clubs must have five qualities to become strong clubs. They are: 1. Have meaningful community activities, 2. Meet the needs of club members, 3. Aggressively reach and recruit new members, 4. Be open to new technologies, and 5. Share Ideas between members and beyond the club.

Clubs should have a effective public relations. At least 1 member of each club should be a member of the media. Lions should work to disprove the saying that "Lions Clubs are the best kept secret in town."

The youth of our community need to be encouraged with a vision of community service through Leo Clubs and youth outreach such as Lions Quest.
