- 1. Change of requirements for the Emergency Fund.

- 3. Resolution to adopt a family dues structure to encourage membership growth for family friendly clubs. If passed, effective 1/1/07, the first member pays full International Dues. 2nd-4th members pay 1/2 dues.
- 4. Resolution revising the procedure of redistricting to require the approval of the sub-district and multiple district convention prior to consideration by the International Board.
- 5. Resolution changing the eligibility of sub districts to nominate candidates for 2nd International Vice President.
- 6. Resolution changing the eligibility of sub districts to nominate candidates for International Director.

Editor Note- Resolutions 5 and 6 will take away the right of Transitional Districts to nominate candidates for International Office. If this rule was in effect last year, our current International Director would be ineligible to serve.

Lions Clubs International, Lions of Massachusetts and the Massachusetts Eye and Ear Infirmary offer these sightsaving tips:

- Leave it to the professionals: Pack a picnic and attend a professional fireworks display.
- Leave it to the adults: Don't let children ignite fireworks or stand near others who do.
- Keep your distance: View fireworks displays from at least 500 feet away, and keep away from lighted fireworks. Many injuries occur when checking on fireworks that have failed to ignite.
- Wear eye protection: Eyeglasses or sunglasses can help protect the eyes from smoke, falling ash and stray sparks.
