Smoking is prohibited on the church premises.

District raffle tickets that have been sold need to be turned in to Lion Judy Tinker or Lion Clara Hobbs at the front table. There are many unsold tickets if anyone would like to purchase one.

To encourage the participation of clubs in displaying their club banner, there would be no banner "stealing" and any club caught doing so would receive a 10,000 point penalty in the District Governor's Contest.
