District Governor Lester Dean welcomed all to today's session. He announced that our District had won Lighthouse and White Cane Day awards. Both were for the highest amount contributed.


Lion Charlie Andrews, Tail Twister, did his thing for the last time in Lester's year, In all the excitement it wasn't reported as to how much was collected.
