LANGUAGE OF LIONISM

A-1 Report	completed and filed by the club secretary by June 30 showing club activities for the year by categories; sent to DG and LCI
cabinet	consists of the DG, Cabinet Secretary, Cabinet Treasurer, Immediate PDG, region and zone chairs
district	a geographic area consisting of a minimum of 36 Lions Club and a minimum of 1250 Lions
CC	Council Chair. Chosen by the incoming council to preside over council meetings. A PDG
Council	Consists of the sitting DGs and the CC
DG	District Governor. An International position. Elected by the district to preside over the area for 1 year. In transition districts, must be appointed by the International Board
DGE	District Governor Elect. Title of the incoming DG
GLCB	Georgia Lions Camp for the Blind. Located in Waycross, GA, at Laura Walker State Park. A Lions of Georgia project.
ID	International Director. Elected by delegates to the International Convention to serve on the International Board for 2 years
IP	International President. Elected by delegates to the International Convention to serve for 1 year
LCI	Lions Clubs International
LCIF	Lions Clubs International Foundation. Responsible for LCI projects and charities. Manages grants.
Leader Dog	Leader Dogs for the Blind. Located in Rochester, MI. Provides trained dogs for sight impaired. Also provides mobility training.

LEO	Lions youth organization; organized by a Lions Club to provide a means for youth ages to age 18 with opportunities for community service
Lighthouse	Georgia Lions Lighthouse Foundation. A Lions of Georgia project to provide surgeries, sight services, and hearing services to those less fortunate.
MD	Multiple District. Consists of a geographic area with several districts.
MMR	Monthly Membership Report. Completed and filed by the club secretary showing membership by categories for the month. Sent to LCI and the DG
PCC	Past Council Chair
PDG	Past District Governor
PID	Past International Director
PIP	Past International President
PU101	report completed and filed by club secretary showing incoming club officers. Due to DG by April 15. Due to LCI by May 31
RB&D	Recordings for the Blind and Dyslexic
region	area of a district consisting of 2-4 zones; presided over by region chair
SEGD	Southeast Guide Dogs; provides trained dogs for sight and mobility impaired; located near Tampa, FL
VDG	Vice District Governor. Elected for 1 year to serve as assistant to the DG. Will qualify for election as DG.
zone	area of the district consisting of 4-8 clubs presided over by a zone chair
